05. Corrija as sentenças que estejam erradas. Explique porque elas estão erradas.

- a. She don't studies English.
She doesn't study English - com o pronome "she" devemos sempre usar "doesn't" ou "does not" na negativa e o verbo principal (no caso "study") não deve ser alterado.
- b. Does your father speaks German?
Does your father speak German? - em sentenças interrogativas devemos usar "does" com a terceira pessoa e o verbo principal (no caso "speak") não deve ser alterado.
- c. Does you live in a big city?
Do you live in a big city? - com o pronome "you" usamos "do" na interrogativa e não "does".
- d. I doesn't know the answer.
I don't know the answer. - com o pronome "I" a negativa é sempre com "don't" ou "do not".
- e. Do it rain a lot where you live?
Does it rain a lot where you live? - com o pronome "it" devemos usar "does" na interrogativa e não "do".

- f. Does Alessandra and her sister play volleyball?
Do Alessandra and her sister play volleyball? - com a terceira pessoa do plural (they) devemos sempre usar “do” na interrogativa e não does. Lembre-se que “Alessandra and her sister” equivale a “elas”, logo “they”.
- g. Do they goes to the movies every week?
Do they go to the movies every week? - com a terceira pessoa do plural (they) usamos “do” nas sentenças interrogativas, mas o verbo principal (no caso “go”) não deve ser alterado.
- h. I doesn’t like that.
I don’t like that. - com as primeiras pessoas (“I” e “we”) devemos sempre usar “don’t” ou “do not” na negativa.
- i. Do they plays any musical instrument?
Do they play any musical instrument? - com a terceira pessoa do plural (they) usamos “do” nas sentenças interrogativas, mas o verbo principal (no caso “play”) não deve ser alterado.
- j. My brother and I work at the same company.
My brother and I work at the same company. - essa sentença está correta.
